Threats/limitations to greater EU cooperation

EU has been internally focused with successive crises

Lack of EU consensus on issues like South China Sea conflicts, North Korea, and the rise of China

Differing approaches and interpretation by EU Member States of the Indo-Pacific Strategy, 'One China Policy'

Focus on economic relationships

Security/defense interest in the regions from few EU Member States

Lack of clarity from US as a partner in the region and in Europe
